






This list contains some of the chain styles available along with some of the alternative names they are also known as (AKA).

You will find chain in various thicknesses and therefore strengths. Chain can be soldered or not. A few of the most common chain link formats are:

Chain link	Picture	Description
Belcher		AKA rolo/rollo is usually used for bracelets.
Cable		Has uniform round or oval links (looks like jump rings joined together).
Curb		Oval links that are twisted to lie flat.
Extension Chain		A short length of chain, usually with a small decoration on one end, used to allow you to make a necklace a few centimetres longer.
Figaro		Long and short curb chain links joined together.

You will also find cable chain with alternating long and short links.
