



Materials:

- 22 beads
- 1 pair earring hooks
- 22 fine headpins
- 2 x 10mm faceted round beads (optional)
- 2 x 20mm eyepins (optional)

These earrings can be as long as you like. Add 4 more beads & headpins for each extra cluster. Each earring weighs 10g.

Tools:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire Cutters

Approx. time to complete: 30+ minutes (not including design time).



Instructions:

1. Thread a 10mm round bead on a 20mm eye pin and make a loop on the other end. Open the loop and attach to the earring hook. Close the loop.

Put aside for final step.



2. Make as many wrapped loop bead drops as desired. For this project I've made 22.

See Basics for how to make a wrapped loop.



3. Open a 6mm jump ring and attach 3 bead drops. Close jump ring.



4. Open a 6mm jump ring and attach a bead drop, the jump ring from the cluster created in step 3 above, and another bead drop. Close jump ring.



5. Repeat step 3 attaching to the previous jump ring as many times as required, in this case three more times.

On the last time after completing step 3, attach the earring/bead created in step 1 above.

Repeat for other earring.
